

Question;

- 5) Ezekiel Chapter 34 speaks to the fact that Israel during this period is protected by God, See vs. 25-29. Also, 36:37-38 "People as numerous as sheep". Ezekiel Chapter 37 speaks about restoring Israel, see verses 25-26.
- 6) Amos chapter 9 speaks about how when God restores Israel to its homeland it is forever, indicating for all future generations. See verses 11-15.

7) Revelations 20:8 , this verse speaks to the fact that after the 1000 year reign of Christ and Satan is released their will be a lot of people who Satan has convinced to challenge Jesus for control of the earth. "In number they are like the sand on the seashore." We also, know from Rev. 19:21 at the end of the Tribulations there are not many people left alive.
